 - Praying – Men of Christ are those who pray earnestly and continually, making “petitions, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving” to God's glory, instructing others to do the same as they further the Kingdom of God.

- **Three most important S.M.A.R.T Goals for this Ministry for the Year 2021**

2. Have 75% of all Chartered Men's Units start a class meeting and/or a Bible Study weekly.
3. Start at least 10 new UMM Local units and have them along with current chartered units participate in a mission project with us or with other men's groups in the community showing the love of Jesus Christ.

1. 25% of UMC churches have an active men's ministry with three or more members (regardless of charter status).
2. Two or more ADUMM leaders have a formal meeting (in person or virtual) with at least 4 Annapolis District pastors that do not have a men's ministry to identify why not, and if desired, help establish one.
